RE: Ongoing Concerns with Tygetshaugh Court (sent via e mail)

Dear Kenneth,

I am writing once again regarding the ongoing situation at Tygetshaugh Court following the outsourcing of social care provision last month. Over recent months, I have repeatedly raised several serious concerns about the operational progression of the outsourcing process on behalf of residents and their families. The fact that many of these concerns remained outstanding at the point when care packages were transferred to external providers is extremely concerning. It has placed residents in a precarious position and has caused distress to families who hoped for a smooth and safe transition.

I want to make you aware that all the concerns I have raised to date about the quality and consistency of care in Tygetshaugh Court now being delivered remain active. I stand fully by the accuracy of the issues I have highlighted, and I remain troubled by the reports I continue to receive from the families and residents of Tygetshaugh Court.

For this reason, it is vital that Falkirk Council, in its operational statutory role as a housing provider, and the Health and Social Care Partnership take immediate steps to assess the adequacy of the new arrangements, the performance of the external providers, and the safety and wellbeing of the residents.
